**JOB TITLE:** Registered Environmental Health Specialist - Per-Diem

**JOB DESCRIPTION:** The employee in this classification under supervision from a licensed health officer carries out a municipal program of environmental sanitation, communicable disease control; enforces various codes and ordinances pertaining to public health and investigates complaints.

**EXAMPLES OF WORK:** (Illustrative Only - may not include all duties performed.)  
Inspects establishments, health of food handlers, cleanliness of preparation of food and wholesomeness of ingredients, sanitation and safety such places of public assembly as camps, schools, and public bathing places and nursing homes for state certification, boarding homes for children and day care centers for state sanitary code regulations.

Investigates, where required, private sewage disposal system and private potable water supplies for avoidance or abatement of nuisance conditions. Investigates communicable disease cases. Will assist in preparation of clinical and health education programs.

Participates in an insect and rodent control program, other programs such as air pollution control, hazardous and toxic waste control, rabies clinic control, poison ivy and ragweed control, solid waste control and inspection and mobile home inspection for sanitary code compliance.

**MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS/QUALIFICATIONS:**

Knowledge of health inspection procedures, relevant codes and ordinances set forth by the municipal government and the state. Skills in collection of samples for laboratory analysis. Ability to: interpret public health laws; develop proper inspection programs; participate as a court witness on matters pertaining to non-compliance with health regulations and violations; and initiate corrective action against health violators.

New Jersey Registered Environmental Health Specialist license. Possession of a valid driver's license issued by the State of New Jersey.
